The University of Library Studies and Information Technologies welcomes scientific paper presentations to the 22nd National Scientific Conference with International Participation " Knowledge Society and 21st Century Humanism", dedicated to the Leaders of the Bulgarian Revival. In 2024, the conference is dedicated to the 200th Anniversary of the publication of the emblematic book for the Bulgarian National Revival - "Fish Primer" by Dr. Petar Beron /1824/.
